Intensive English Program*

- Interactive and communicative classes available in speaking, writing, grammar, listening and reading
- 13-week program (start dates in May and September)
- Part-time and full-time study options
- I-20 for F-1 student visa issued for full-time language study

Speaking and Listening for Communication*

- Designed to meet the needs of individuals who cannot take courses during the workday
- Class focuses on speaking and listening across contexts, but reading and writing may be included

Community Conversation Course

- Interactive, communicative classes focusing on speaking and listening (start dates in September and January)
- Taught by University student volunteers and teachers-intraining

Professional and Academic English Program

- Intensive six-week program for graduate and professional students (June-July)
- Immersion in culture and language experienced in academic and professional environments
- I-20 for F-1 student visa issued for full-time language study

Conditional Admission Options

- Explore the <u>Path to Pitt</u> program that provides guaranteed admission, an alternate to conditional admission, to undergraduate applicants who are academically ready but need additional English training
- Take advantage of <u>conditional admission alternatives</u> and TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo waiver options for eligible students with partner programs and universities
